



KOSCIUSZKO THREDBO DRONE PROHIBITION POLICY

To maximise safety for guests, employees, and resort property, Kosciuszko Thredbo Pty Ltd prohibits the unauthorised operation or use of any Remotely Piloted Aircraft or any form of Aerial Drones within our leasehold area. This includes recreational users and unauthorised commercial users – prohibiting drone use unless approved by Kosciuszko Thredbo Pty Ltd.

This prohibition includes drones for filming, as well as any drone use by media or journalists operating over any property under the ownership or control of Kosciuszko Thredbo Pty Ltd. This policy applies to all commercial operators, members of the public, staff, sublessees and volunteers.

This prohibition on drone operations or use extends to any drones launched or operated from Kosciuszko Thredbo Pty Ltd property, as well as drones launched from within the Thredbo Village. No enquiries will be entertained from recreational users however commercial operators can contact media@thredbo.com.au for further information.

Any violation of this prohibition policy may include the suspension of your lift pass, confiscation of any equipment and subsequent reporting to the NSW Police. Individuals may be subject to litigious action for violation of privacy, injury to third party and breach of subsequent legislation.
